#### **CRITERIA FOR STUDENTS:**

- \* Complete online application and pay a one-time application fee of \$25.
- \* Official transcripts from all colleges/universities attended\*
- \* Undergraduate GPA of 3.0 (institutional or last 60 hour count) or undergraduate GPA of 2.5-2.99 GPA (institutional or last 60 hours) or higher with corresponding GRE. Students who do not have a 3.0 GPA (institutional or last 60 hours) must have a qualifying GRE score within the first 9 credit hours. Admission score will be developed with the formula  $GPA \times 50 + GRE$  (composite of Verbal and Quantitative)  $> \text{ or } = 428$  Graduate forms found at: <http://graduatestudies.lamar.edu/forms.html>

#### **GRE Policy**

For applicants to graduate programs in the College of Education and Human Development (online and on campus), students with a 3.0 GPA undergrad or 3.0 in their last 60 hours are admitted unconditionally. Students required to take the GRE must meet the institutional GRE and GPA standard. **GRE taken after August 2011:** Undergraduate GPA (cumulative or last 60 hours, whichever is higher)  $\times 50 +$  GRE Verbal + GRE quantitative  $=/ \text{ or } >$  greater than 428.
